

# Questions for a Job Interview

It is best to review these questions <u>prior to</u> a job interview and know the answer that you would prefer to hear from the potential employer.

## **EMPLOYMENT BASICS**

- 1. What is the process for hiring? Who is the hiring manager?
- 2. Who will I be reporting to for daily work?
- 3. If I am offered a position and I accept, how long before I can start working?
- 4. Does the company provide insurance credentialling, scheduling, marketing, billing, collecting cost shares, lab requests, pharmacy support, cleaning the office space, tissues, faxes, drug screening, LAIs
- 5. Do you have a designated privacy officer?
- 6. Do you have a designated compliance officer?
- 7. How are patient complaints typically handled?

## **PAY AND BENEFITS**

- 1. What benefits are included with this position?
- 2. Do you cover malpractice insurance? If so, do you know the limits?
- 3. When do the benefits start? Is there a waiting period?
- 4. Am I paid for No-shows or other missed appointments?
- 5. Will there be performance reviews annually or some other frequency?
- 6. If paid on a split- What is your net-collection ratio?
- 7. Salary-What is the minimum number of patients or CPT codes required to be billed weekly?
- 8. Are there restrictions in the contract such as a non-compete? Is it OK if I work somewhere else as well?
- 9. Will I have access to UpToDate or other clinical support software?



## **CLINICAL PRACTICE CONCERNS**

- 1. Does someone to help with coding my notes?
- 2. What equipment will I need to bring? Computer, scale, stethoscope, office furniture, office decorations, business cards, name placard, etc.
- 3. When are the notes required to be completed after the visit?
- 4. Am I required to stand overnight call?
- 5. How are patient needs handled after hours?

## NP-PHYSICIAN COLLABORATION

- 1. How do you handle NP-physician collaboration? Is someone assigned or do I need to find someone on my own?
- 2. Who pays for this?
- 3. Does the company provide any forms to document the agreement and collaboration?
- 4. Will I have my own patients or mostly see follow-up appointments after the physician has seen the patient?
